- provide a catalyst to transform women's lives.

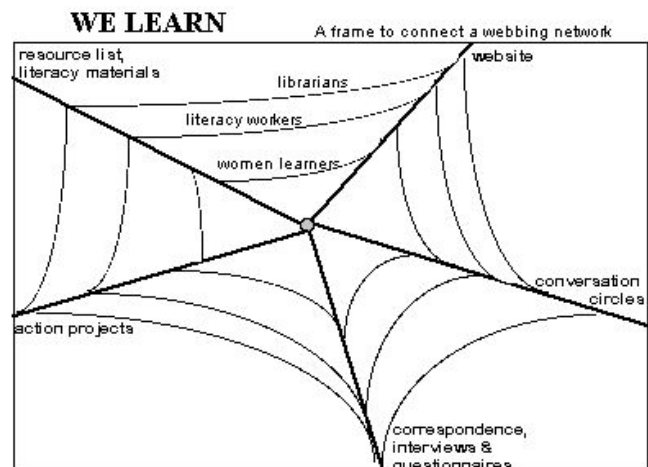
